In pursuance of Postal Directorate, New Delhi vide letter No. X-4/2/2020-SPN-II dated 09.02.2024 & 07.05.2024, the Competent Authority is pleased to issue regular promotion order of following official of the LSG (RMS) cadre to the HSG-II (RMS) cadre, in the Pay Level-6 of of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix (pre revised Pay Band-2, Rs. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay Rs. 4200) against year 2023 on regular basis with immediate effect from the date of assumption of charge in HSG-II (RMS) cadre. The approved officials are allotted to RMS Division as mentioned against his name for further posting. **Posting orders in respect of above official will be issued by concerned Divisional Heads immediately.**

2. The above promotion of the official will take effect from the date on which the official actually join the post of above cadre.

3. If the entitled official who wishes to give an option for choosing date for fixation of pay under FR-22 (I) (a)(1) should do so within one month from the date of assumption of the charge on promotion. Option once exercised is final. Pay may be fixed in accordance with applicable pay matrix introduced in 7<sup>th</sup> CPC.

4. If the above promoted official is already getting higher Level of Pay Matrix by virtue of financial upgradation under TBOP/BCR/MACP, he may continue to get his present Level of Pay Matrix.

5. In case of official, who is not willing to accept above promotion, he/she may submit his/her unconditional declination letter in writing through proper channel within 15 days of issue of this promotion/posting order, but final orders thereon regarding its acceptance/non-acceptance will be issued by competent authority. The officials declining the promotion will lose seniority vis-à-vis their juniors promoted to the above cadre and debarred, subject to all other conditions prescribed.

6. If the above promoted official refuse/decline the regular promotion before becoming entitled to a financial upgradation, no financial upgradation under MACP shall be allowed as such they have not been stagnated due to lack of opportunities. If, however, financial upgradation has been allowed due to stagnation and they subsequently refuse the promotion, it shall not be a ground to withdraw the financial upgradation. They shall, however not be eligible to be considered for further financial upgradation under MACP, till they agree to be considered for promotion again and the second and the next financial upgradation shall also be deferred to the extent of period of debarment due to the refusal.

7. In case any Vigilance/Disciplinary case , of the type referred in O.M. No. 22011/2/86-Estt.(A) dated 12.01.88 from DOP&T circulated vide Directorate No. 25-19/88-SPG dated 04.05.88 (subsequently) revised vide DOP&T Memo No. 22022/04/91/Estt.(A) dtd. 14.09.92 circulated vide Directorate Memo No. 25-19/88-SPG dtd 13.10.92 is pending against the official, she should not be relieved for posting without obtaining specific orders from this office. The official against whom any punishment is current, except censure and recovery of money, should not be relieved for promotion, without obtaining specific orders from this office. A report in this regard be submitted immediately.
8. In case of SC/ST official, the promotion is subject to verification of his caste status.
9. The promotion shall be subject to further orders which may be passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
10. The appointing authority reserves the right either to modify or cancel the promotion, if any official is found not eligible for the promotion or if found necessary for any cause at a later date.
11. The concerned Division will immediately issue formal posting orders and above officials should be relieved under office arrangement to join their new assignment.
